## Interpipe releases its report on operations for July 2021

Interpipe, a global producer of steel pipes and railway products, has released (via Interpipe Holdings Plc) its monthly report on operations for July 2021.

#### Highlights

In July 2021, a steady growth of the Company's operational and trading performance intermitted across all key products as a result of seasonality and delivery schedules under contracts with key off-takers.

**Overall pipe product sales** declined 17.6% m-o-m, however they remained 11.3% y-o-y higher for the first seven months 2021.

**OCTG sales** shaded by 2.7% m-o-m but still stayed above 18 thousand tons (a peak monthly volume since the beginning of 2020). For the first seven months 2021 sales volumes surged by 66.1% as an evidence of bullish sentiments in the global oil & gas market.

Linepipe sales volumes declined by 27.3% m-o-m purely due to formation of cargo consignments and conditions of delivery schedules to key customers in the MENA region as booking of sales under 2 vessels rolled into the beginning of August.

<u>Mechanical pipe sales</u> slid down by 2.7% m-o-m as shipments to the domestic market continued falling after their peak in May having reached the lowest level over this year.

<u>Welded pipe sales</u> decline decelerated (down by 5.7% m-o-m) following a slight upturn in the domestic market that partially off-set a seasonal drop in sales in Europe. However, sales for the seven months 2021 slumped by 37.8% y-o-y having been pressured by market prices for HRC that rallied in H1 2021.

<u>Sales volumes of railway products</u> showed a 15.6% m-o-m decline primarily due to lighter contractual delivery schedule under the contract with the Indian National Railway Operator this month.

At the same time, the Company's management expects getting back to the sustainable monthly level of 15 thousand tons yet in August given 15.5 thousand tons of railway products were manufactured in July.




